

LAJSA is pleased to announce that funds are available for the Jacobo Kovadloff Travel Award in support of members who will be presenting scholarly work at the 17th International Research Conference, June 21–23, 2015, Florida International University (Biscayne Bay Campus). Preference is given to graduate student scholars at the dissertation stage, post-doctoral fellows, and recent PhDs.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Acceptance of your proposed paper by the conference program committee as part of **scholarly panel session or seminar**. Participation in a round table, lightning session, or the presentation of creative work is not eligible for funding.
- LAJSA membership dues must be current for 2015.

To apply, submit the following materials to the chair of the selection committee, Alan Astro (aaastro@trinity.edu), by January 5, 2015. Late submissions will not be considered.

- A brief letter of application stating your current position and academic affiliation (if any); a documented estimate of travel costs (air fare and hotel accommodations). Please include information about how the paper you will be presenting fits into your overall research agenda.
- An advanced draft (8–10 pages) of the paper that was approved for presentation at the conference.

Notification of award will be sent to individual applicants by February 23, 2015. The Jacobo Kovadloff Travel Award is intended to help defray the cost of attending and participating in the conference. Applicants are strongly encouraged to apply for all other funding sources available to them.
