You are invited to submit for consideration your paper from the XIV International Research Conference of **LAJSA** at Tel Aviv University (26-28 of July, 2009) or from the **LAJSA** Conference at the C.U.N.Y. Graduate Center in April 2008, for publication in **Yiddish/ Modern Jewish Studies** in 2010.

Guidelines for submission:

- You need to be a member of the **Latin American Jewish Studies Association** and have presented your paper at either of the above mentioned conferences.
- By the time of submission you should be a member in good standing of **LAJSA**. If your paper is accepted for publication you need to subscribe to **MJS**.
- All papers and quotations should be written / translated in publishable English.
- You should follow the **MLA** style guidelines.
- Papers can be up to 3500 words including notes and works cited.
- All papers will be peer reviewed by scholars in your field (Literature, History, Social Sciences)
- Electronic copies of the paper in Word, along with a short abstract of one paragraph should be sent to Nora Glickman at Nglickman@aol.com.
