**We invite proposals** for both panels and individual papers, though panel proposals are especially favored. A panel consists of three paper presenters and a session chair.

The chair may be one of the paper presenters. Optionally, panel proposals may also include a discussant, who may not be one of the paper presenters.

For **panel proposals**, please send a brief (100-word) description of the panel topic, along with a list of the participants, their affiliations and contact information. There should also be a brief

(150-word) description of each paper to be presented on the panel. *Please be sure to include a title for the session and a title for each individual paper.* The session organizer should gather this information from the other participants and submit it all in a single mailing.

For **individual paper proposals**, please send a 150-word description of your paper *which must include a title*. Identify your affiliation.

All proposed participants need to submit a one-paragraph c.v. emphasizing their involvement in Latin American Jewish Studies and/or Sephardic Studies.

Please remember that all presentations must be on topics in Latin American Jewish Studies and/or Sephardic Studies.

**Participants must be LAJSA members.**

Presentations take up to 20 minutes (about 8 double spaced pages). They may be in Spanish or in English.

Please note that, as has been the case with previous regional conferences in New York, most participants stay with friends or family members, so we will not make group arrangements with a hotel.

If you would like suggestions about lodging, please contact the co-organizers. We regret that we will not be able to provide child care or travel grants.
